



## “It’s Your Job – Know Your Rights”: New Brunswick High School Student Video Contest 2013

New Brunswick high school students were invited to develop and submit a two-minute video on job safety or the rights of employees in the workplace.

Videos were judged on creativity and originality in story development, production value, video effects and overall messaging.

First place contest winners receive a \$1,000 team cash prize; second place, \$750; and third place, \$500. A matching cash prize is awarded to their respective high schools.

Provincial contest winners are:

- **First place:** Moncton High School. Video titled “[Don’t get pushed around](#)”
- **Second place:** Saint Mary’s Academy (Edmundston), Video titled “[Timber](#)”
- **Third place:** École Sainte-Anne (Fredericton), video titled “[Chute fatale](#)”

Winning videos from New Brunswick, and each Canadian jurisdiction, have been submitted to compete at the national contest level for a chance to win additional cash prizes.

National entries will be available to view, and be voted on by Canadian residents, on a designated YouTube channel during an online voting period for “Fan Favourite” from May 4 to 12, 2013. The student or team that receives the most votes in each category will be awarded an additional \$1,000 cash prize.
