



“It’s Your Job – Play it Safe”: New Brunswick High School Student Video Contest 2014

New Brunswick high school students were invited to develop and submit a two-minute video that illustrates the importance of working safely on the job.

Videos were judged on creativity and originality in story development, production value, video effects and overall messaging.

First place contest winners receive a \$1,000 team cash prize; second place, \$750; and third place, \$500. A matching cash prize is awarded to their respective high schools.
