

New Brunswick high school student video contest 2013

Do you aspire to be a filmmaker, or to star in your own film? Do you care about workplace health and safety? Then this contest is for you!



WorkSafeNB, in partnership with the Department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour, has launched a provincial video contest called "It's Your Job – Know Your Rights." The contest challenges New Brunswick high school students to be creative and develop an original video that illustrates to younger workers the importance of working safely on the job or about their right to be treated fairly for the work they do.

The provincial contest closes April 5, 2013. Cash prizes will be awarded to students and their schools. Winners of the New Brunswick video

contest will be automatically entered into the national contest "*It's Your Job*", to compete against high school winners from across the country and be viewed by Canadians coast-to-coast during voting in May 2013! Not in high school? The national contest has a category open to ages 18-24.

Prizes:

First place: A prize of \$1,000 for the student, and \$1,000 for the high school.

Second place: A prize of \$750 for the student, and \$750 for the high school.

Third place: A prize of \$500 for the student, and \$500 for the high school.
